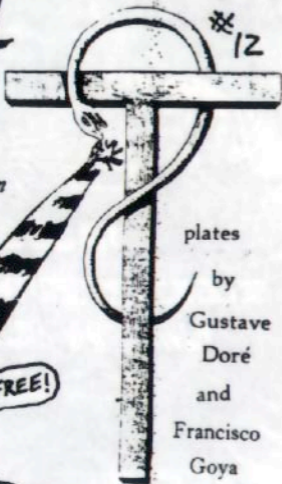

in darkness





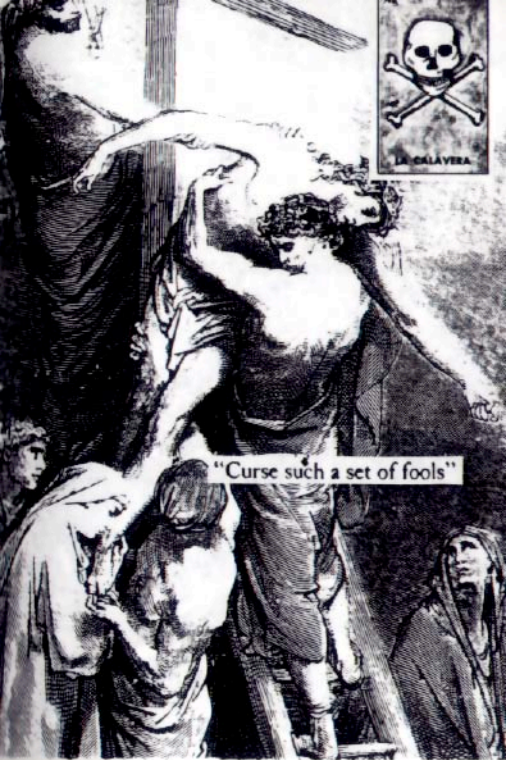
